## 'Millions' invested in new Celco plant

MISSISSAUGA—Celco Inc. Foodservice Equipment has a new home.

The Mississauga-based company recently moved into its new custom-built 23,000-square-foot digs at Kennedy and Derry Roads.

The "several million dollar" investment comes equipped with a demonstration kitchen featuring many products from Celco's principals.

The new plant is almost three times the size of the company's previous headquarters at Mississauga Road and Highway 401.

Celco president Ted Reeser told *ORN* last month he is especially proud of the demonstration kitchen.

"It really looks great," he said. "So far it's proven to be very effective with everyone who's seen or used it."

The kitchen has an Electrolux combi-oven, blast chiller, pasta cooker and two dishwashers; Amana convection oven, toasting oven and high-wattage microwaves; Nieco broilers and Molteni custom-built rotisseries, and island cooking suites. All these brands are represented by Celco.
